

Key Stage 3 | Uniform Guide



School Jumper

All students must wear the black school v-neck jumper with the school badge.



Blazer

All students must wear the school blazer with the school badge.



Tie

All Key Stage 3 students should wear the new Key Stage 3 school tie.



Trousers

These must be plain black, tailored school trousers. Cords, jeans, combats or fashion trousers are unacceptable.



Shirt

Plain blue with collar, long or short sleeved shirt worn tucked in. As the tie is clip on, it is essential your child can fasten the top button.



Skirts

This must be a plain black knee length school skirt.



Shoes

All students must wear sensible plain black school shoes. No trainers, canvas pumps or shoes with sports logos or markings are allowed.

Jewellery & Accessories

All items of jewellery must be small and discreet. One watch, one ring and one pair of stud earrings is allowed. On health and safety grounds, no other piercings or jewellery is allowed. Other items such as wide belts, patterned tights and large hair accessories must not be worn.

Make up

A small amount of make up is acceptable but heavy use will need to be removed. No nail polish or acrylic is allowed.

Hairstyle

Extreme hairstyles are not permitted such as cuts below number 1, unnatural colour dyeing, tramlines or extensions.

PE Uniform



Polo Shirt and Shorts

All students must wear a royal blue school tee shirt with royal blue school shorts. Boys' shorts are shadow striped football shorts.



Fleece or Multipurpose Top

Girls will need a royal blue school fleece and boys will need a royal blue multipurpose top (rugby top).



Tracksuit Trousers and Socks

If students wish to wear tracksuit trousers these must be black with the school badge on them.

Students will need royal blue school sports socks
